## Greetings from new Alumni Assoc. President Stu Johnson

There are some big shoes to be filled in the FHS Alumni Assoc. in that Pam Knuth ('75), the only president this association has ever had, retired from this office after eight years of faithful and productive service.

Pam, who was honored last May with the alumni's "Order of the Kite" award will be staying on the board of directors and will lead the committee responsible for publishing the Alumni Post and any direct-mail flyers pertaining to other association activities.

In a nutshell, the single goal of the FHSAA, as outlined in our bylaws, is to establish ongoing alumni interest in and financial support for the pursuit of educational excellence and promote further development of Franklin High School.

It takes more than just the seventeen alumni board members to bring our goals to fruition. Currently we have just under 500 paid up alumni members supporting our cause. This is encouraging, but considering that the mailing of the Alumni Post goes out at least twice a year to approximately ten thousand addresses each time, it leaves room for a healthy increase in membership. Additional members, paying fifteen dollars annual dues would dramatically improve our ability to help those students in need and also provide many of the materials needed to aesthetically improve our alma mater.

projects. First is the "Student Hunger" program, assisting the Student Leadership class of Mrs. Susie Bartley in providing additional nutrition to students in need and thereby enhancing the learning process.

Secondly, under the auspices of Jamie's Rock and Roll Legends (Jamie Goetz '69) Justin Shandor and band will perform two separate shows impersonating Elvis Presley singing music from the 50's, 60's, and 70's. He's known internationally as the very best! These fundraising concerts will be held in the FHS auditorium February 22, 2014, with a matinee at 2:00 and the evening show beginning at 6:00 PM.

Last but not least will be the 100 year anniversary celebrating the long life and endurance of our cherished house of learning. An all-class alumni banquet will be held in the Grand Ballroom of the Jantzen Beach Red Lion Hotel, June 14, 2014.

These last two social engagements are covered in their entirety within this special Alumni Post edition.

The Alumni Board of Directors looks forward to the challenges of this coming fiscal year in serving all Quakers, past, present and future. Together we can help by promoting and providing educational excellence and furthering the ongoing development of Benjamin Franklin High School. 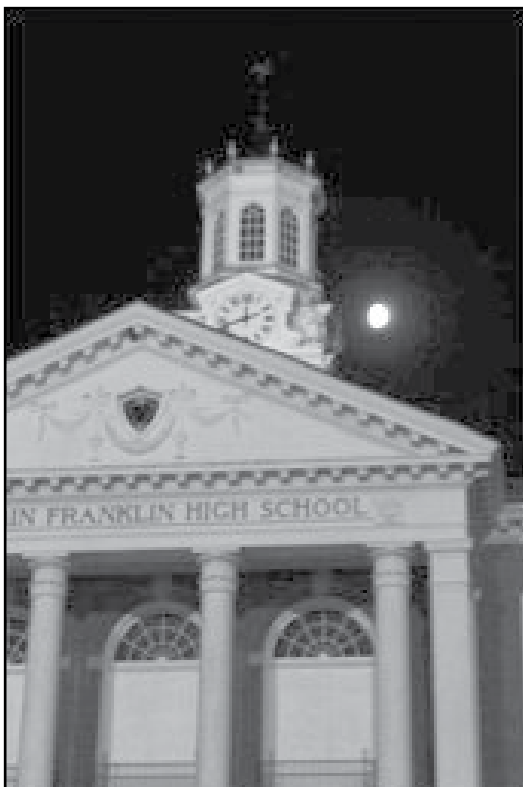
In the late afternoon, The Beat Goes On Band, entertained guests prior to the FHS vs. Wilson PIL football game. By the way, Franklin won!

members should be on the FHSAA Alumni Association Board and may volunteer to participate in the selection process.

November: review the nominations and determine which nominees they will recommend for citations.

January: the FHSAA Board reviews the recommendations from the Citation Committee and makes the final decisions about who will be the recipients for the following year.

February: the President of the FHSAA Board or designee(s) will contact the award recipients, notifying them of this honor and asking them to block a day in the spring to participate in the ceremony and

participate in some morning classes at Franklin. May: the Distinguished Alums are introduced to students during the morning and will participate in some classes, related to their field of achievement, and will then be feled at the annual Alumni Membership Luncheon celebration. The honors will be awarded jointly by the Principal of Franklin High School and the President of the FHSAA.

Awards Reception: The awards reception would be conducted at the annual membership luncheon for which the FHSAA would charge admission. The admission fee would cover the costs of the event and should also provide some residual income to be shared between the "operation budget" of the FHSAA and some funds donated to the scholarship fund. For example, if the event costs averaged \$30.00 per attendee, we would charge \$50.00 for the event, thus providing a source of income as well as a distinguished event for the award recipients. FHSAA would cover the costs for the award recipients to attend the event, and these costs would be included in the calculation of the per-person charges that would be assessed to financially cover the costs of the event.

Anticipated Costs: The award recipients would need to pay for all of their expenses to attend the awards presentation and to visit students at Franklin. FHSAA would cover the award recipients' costs to attend the luncheon. # Jamie Goetz, Promoter of Elvis tribute fundraiser concert at Franklin H.S.

Jamie Goetz, Class of '69, returns to Franklin High School more than four decades after graduating to help Franklin celebrate its 100 Anniversary and to raise money for the Franklin Endowment. Next Feb. 22nd, he will produce two shows featuring Justin Shandor, the best Elvis impersonator on the 2010 Ultimate Elvis reality show. Shandor will fly back from Las Vegas to appear in the Franklin High auditorium for a 2:00 matinee of Elvis music from the 50's and 60's, then a 6:00 evening show of 70's hit songs. Goetz and the Alumni Assoc. hope these concerts will help raise money for the Franklin Endowment which

promotes and produces educational excellence at the school.

Mr. Goetz, these days is the manager of Jamie's Rock and Roll Legends, managing top look-alike, sound-alike tribute artists in shows all over the world. Jamie still plays drums in some of the acts when he is in town. He has been performing nearly his whole

life, as a drummer in garage bands like Gentleman Jim and the Horsemen during high school and an award-winning drummer in the Air Force

Band (see picture) during the 1970's. After military service, Jamie attended class at George Fox University before starting his entertainment company.

# Make It a Centennial Weekend

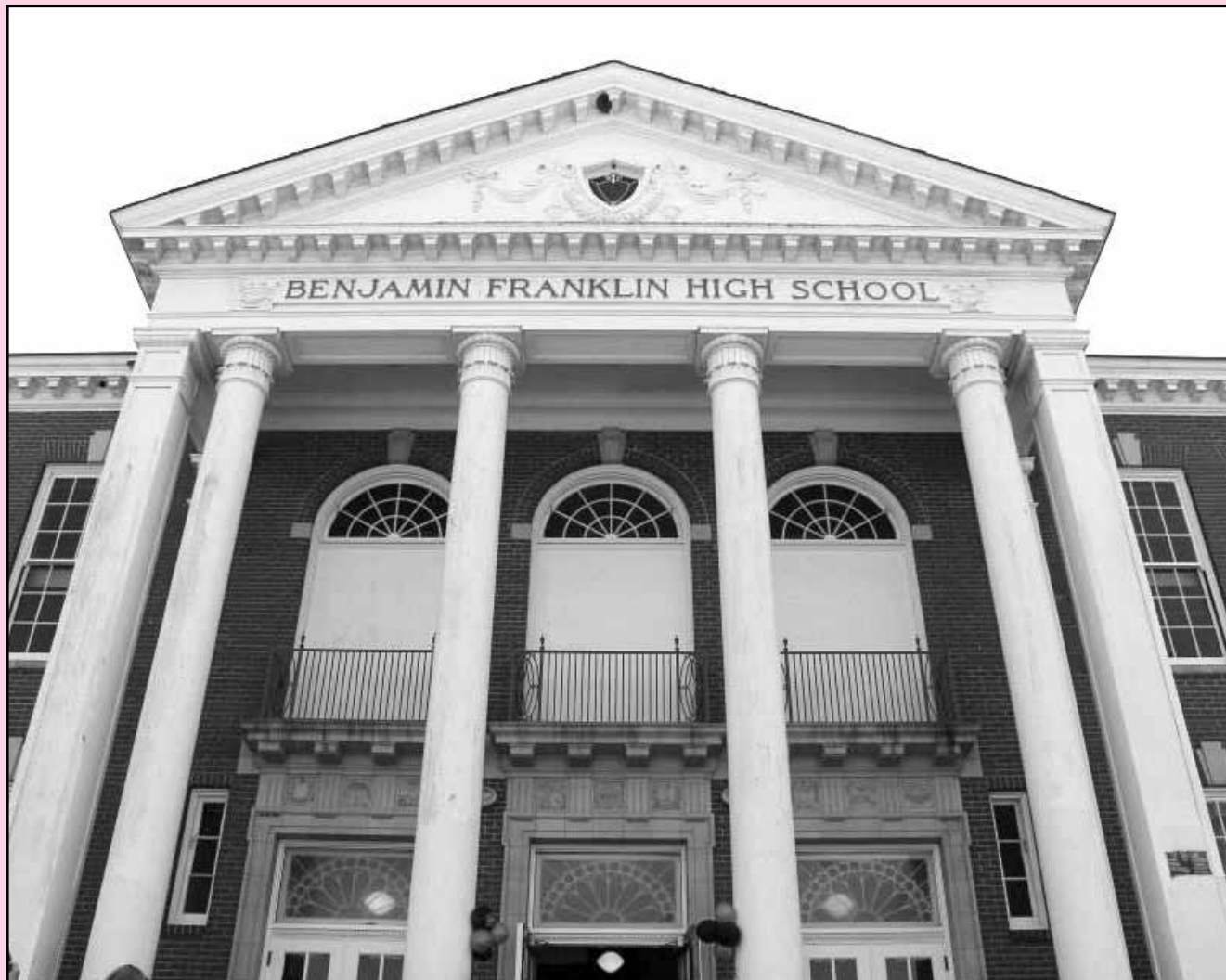
Quaker alums, faculty, staff and friends are invited to Franklin's Centennial Weekend in June, 2014.
